About the speaker

Sander Kersten, Ph.D. is the director of the Division of Nutritional Sciences and the Schleifer Family Professor at Cornell University. After earning his Ph.D. at Cornell and postdoctoral work in Lausanne, Switzerland, Dr. Kersten spent nearly 25 years at Wageningen University, the Netherlands, where he became Full Professor and Chair of the Nutrition, Metabolism and Genomics group, before rejoining Cornell in 2024. Research in his group aims to elucidate the molecular mechanism that underlies the regulation of lipid metabolism in the liver and adipose tissue during fasting and feeding.
